- Develop and refine artistic work for presentation.
- Convey meaning through the presentation of artistic work.
- Perceive and analyze artistic work.
- Interpret intent and meaning in artistic work.
- Synthesize and relate knowledge and personal experiences to make art.
- Relate artistic ideas and works with societal, cultural, and historical context to deepen understanding.

#### Students are graded on:

- Studio projects (art projects)
- Daily class participation
- Self assessments (rubrics)
- Artist statements
- Sketchbooks

- ★ Students will be working with drawing, acrylic paint, paper mache, printmaking, and collage.
- ★ Students retaking Art as an **8th grader** (they had art as a 7th grader) are considered **Art**II and will be given advanced assignments.

# Participation:

Students are graded on participation and behavior in class. Students are not allowed to have the following in class:

- Hoods
  - Hoods are not allowed to be worn during class
- Cell phones
  - Cell phones are a distraction and are not permitted to be in the classroom at any time. Students must keep cell phones in their lockers.
- Earbuds and headphones
  - o Earbuds and headphones are not allowed in class.

#### Grading:

Grading will be based on the Marzano's Standards based grading system. Students will be evaluated on whether or not they met the National Core Art Standard in their projects and class participation.
